Mounting instructions

Mounting film decals

- 1. Clean the mounting location thoroughly with alcohol on a lint-free cloth/paper. A clean surface makes for neat mounting.
- 2. Attach the decal with masking tape on each side. This helps to hold the decal so you can measure it to the correct location. For larger items, also place a piece vertically in the middle of the decal.
- 3. Pull off the strip of backing paper at the top and press the front liner firmly into place.
- 4. Cut between words/letters if necessary to facilitate mounting. Turn the decal upside down and peel off the rest of the backing paper.
- 5. Then fold the decal back, but keep it away from the surface, and start scraping. Scrape with firm pressure from the centre and out towards the side of the decal. It is important to overlap the movement so that air is pushed out.
- 6. Remove the masking tape from the middle and repeat on the other half.
- 7. If the decal has tape on, peel off the tape at a 180 degree angle. Pull gently, making sure that the corner of the decal and the film don't move up. If the film slips, gently scrape the film back into place.

If there are air bubbles in the film, you can use a needle and poke a hole in one side, and then scrape softly from the opposite side.
